INTRODUCTION

If you work with people, whether as a coach, organisational consultant or leader, trainer, mediator, health specialist, counsellor or similar roles – you may have heard of Transactional Analysis (TA), a psychological approach to behaviour and communication.

Systemic Transactional Analysis (STA) is a non-clinical approach to the practice of TA. It is for those who work with their clients to promote growth and development mostly, but not exclusively in the organisational context.

It is widely recognised today that people live and work within systems – family constellations, friendship groups, wider national cultures and organisational systems. As professional educators we need to understand the connections, dynamics and the contexts of relationships in order to support our clients to solve their problems, increase competence and gain confidence. Systems thinking, coupled with TA provides a robust theoretical framework for us to apply and share with the community in which we work.

QUALIFICATION

You may be an organisational practitioner who has worked towards a the Certified Transactional Analyst status run by organisations such as the International TA Association (ITAA) or the European Association of Transactional Analysis (EATA), but for a variety of reasons have decided not to continue. Or you may be new to the psychological approach to human behaviour, known as Transactional Analysis. People with all levels of experience and hours of application of TA are welcome.

Lynda Tongue (Teaching and Supervising Transactional Analyst in the organisational field) offers a new interim qualification which is designed to accredit those who demonstrate to her that they have the ability to apply TA concepts from an ethical base.

Please note that qualification is not mandatory – you may feel you do not need to qualify but want ongoing supervision of your work from a TA perspective, and/or you simply wish to improve your skills of communication with a framework of concepts and theories that

can enhance conversations and also give you valuable information to share with your clients.

TA TRIBE – ONLINE TRAINING AND SUPERVISION

Lynda Tongue (TSTA-org) offers a mentoring approach, supporting trainees to develop their professional skills when working with clients applying Transactional Analysis generally in the organisational context.

The Certificate and Diploma in Systemic Transactional Analysis are designed to be flexible, practical and accessible. The online TA Practitioner Programme currently offers ten monthly workshops on core concepts, with more being planned. In addition, an open-ended programme offers workshops under the ‘Deep Dive’ name. Lynda also runs supervision online, one to one and in a group setting.

TA PRACTITIONER PROGRAMME: Lynda offers a programme of online workshops for those who want to learn about the theory and application of TA. These are open to all who are interested in developmental TA work.

TA SUPERVISION GROUP: a monthly group to work with others in a supervision setting – practitioners present aspects of their client work for supervision with Lynda. It is also possible to use this session to work towards the Systemic TA Practitioner Certificate and Diploma. Practitioners present client work and recordings for analysis.

ONE TO ONE SUPERVISION: one hour to present client work and recordings for analysis.

WHEN CAN I START?!

Depending on your experience of TA, you can start at any time to suit you. If you have some TA training hours already, it may be possible to apply for Accreditation of Prior Learning which would be discussed with Lynda

NEW TO TA - if you are new to TA, join the occasional online workshops covering the core concepts of Transactional Analysis, with a focus on application from a systems perspective.

EXPERIENCED IN TA - if you have some TA training but are not qualified, or if you are a TA psychotherapist who now wants to work in organisations, there may be a requirement to undertake certain modular work focussing on a systemic approach.
