Lynda Tongue (Teaching and Supervising Transactional Analyst – org) launched TA Tribe in 2016 as a response to a growing disquiet about the inaccessibility of Transactional Analysis (TA) training and supervision in general.

The requirement to attend years of monthly training weekends, face-to-face with all of the accompanying accommodation and travel costs put the path to TA qualifications in the bracket of ‘only for those who can afford it’. Not to mention the contribution to climate change with regular flights for many Also many people have care responsibilities for children or family members so being away for six or seven days is too difficult. Still others have challenges around mobility.

Lynda had been conducting supervision online prior to 2016, and also workshops - long before Zoom came along with functions such as whiteboards and syndicate ‘rooms’ – so she had experience in delivering online. She worked out a format, and launched TA Tribe at the Geneva TA conference in 2016.

Lynda has built up a bank of workshop outlines and can offer different workshop formats with accompanying theory papers and scope for discussion in syndicates and plenty of activities to offer opportunities to ‘play’ with the material or subject matter.

TA Tribe offers an online place to connect, to discover and to learn. It is a place to meet people from other cultures and countries, an opportunity to deepen your TA knowledge to apply in your professional role.
